Very nice polish, to this with blackberry and blueberry character. Medium body with polished tannins and a cherry finish. Very attractive. An estate to watch from this appellation.

The deep puple_hued 2020 château Bernon Becot boasts loads of ripe black (and some blue) fruits that are supported by solid aromatics of licorice, graphite, and scorched earth.

With plenty of classic right bank minerality, medium to full bodied richness, and building tannins, this is a serious beauty that will benefit from a few years of bottle age and shine for over a decade.

The 2020 Bernon Becot offers a good bit of immediacy, but also comes across a bit simple in this tasting. There is good depth to the fruit, but not a ton of complexity. I would prefer to drink this Puisseguin st Emilion over the near and medium term.

The 2020 Bernon Bécot has a light pencil box and undergrowth bouquet with sufficient black fruit to pull off this atypical classic take on the vintage. The medium-bodied palate offers fine tannins, well-judged acidity, and tobacco and graphite-infused, quite vibrant black fruit on the finish. It's a right bank with left bank aspirations.
